The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Wednesday, April 5, 2023. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members: Henry Walser, Jim Allison, Norman Schippert, Paige Bjorn, Angelica Shea and Emily Rademaker. Also in attendance were City Attorney, John Singler and city clerk Denise Haney

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Henry Walser made a Motion to approve the March 2023 minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Paige Bjorn seconded the motion, and all Council Members present voted in favor.

The mayor is assessing the bids for repaving Stoney Creek Court. The mayor thanked the fire department and LG&E for their help during the windstorm to clear roads and restore power. 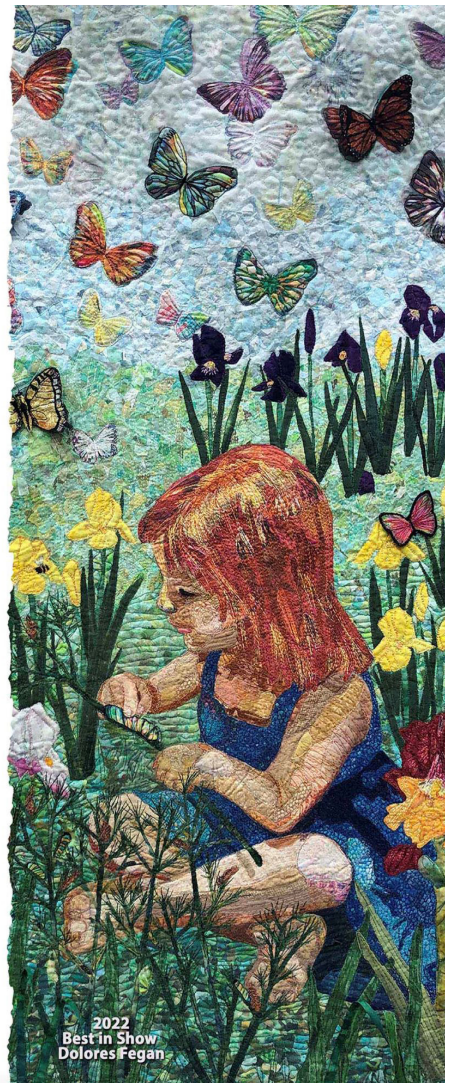

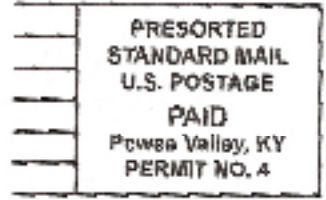
