MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL  
Monday, August 1, 2016

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, August 1, 2016. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Rex Florence, Paige Bjorn, Norman Schippert, Bethany Major, and Dick Filippini. Also in attendance were John Singler, City Attorney and Laura Eichenberger, City Clerk. Council Member Henry Walser was absent.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A motion was made by Norman Schippert to approve the July 6, 2016 Minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Paige Bjorn seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

**Financial Report**

The Profit & Loss vs. Actual and Balance Sheet reports through July 31, 2016 from the Treasurer were distributed in the Council Member meeting packets. Mayor Rogers stated the City has received the certified property tax assessment and the tax roll has been sent to the company that generates the tax bills.

Sidewalks—Norman Schippert

Norman Schippert reported we are now waiting on the contractor to begin work on the sidewalk along Highway 146.

Town Hall/Festivities/Central Park—Bethany Major

Bethany Major reported there are plans for additional plantings around Central Park this Fall.

The Pewee Valley Historical Society met in July. The group is reviewing and choosing photos for display in the Town Hall Museum. Bethany thanked Donna Russell for going above and beyond the call of duty finding historical photos and items for the museum, researching grants, signage, and writing the content for the Historical Society website. There are also volunteers scanning all the old issues of the Call of the Pewee and Donna is uploading them to the website.

Roads and Drainage/Environmental Board—Bob Rogers

Last Thursday evening, July 28<sup>th</sup>, a sinkhole opened at the intersection of Rosswood and Ridgewood Drives. Friday morning the Hosler family (Quality Grading) brought all the equipment needed to dig it out, fix it, and cover it. The hole was three to four feet deep. The City is applying to the State for assistance from the Municipal Road Aid Emergency

Fund. Mayor Rogers thanked the Hosler family and the City Engineer, Mel Milburn, for their quick response to the situation.

**New Business**

Permanent Sign Application: Schur Funeral Home

Following revisions to the original application, Bob Rueff of the Rueff Sign Company, made adjustments to the sign to comply with County and City regulations. The sign will be 10 feet in height and have an opaque background, so that only the letters reading “Schurr Funeral Home” and “schurfh.com” will be illuminated at night.

Norman Schippert motioned to approve the revised Permanent Sign Application. Bethany Major seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

A motion was made by Rex Florence to pay the bills, seconded by Paige Bjorn. All Council Members present voted in favor.

Rex Florence motioned to adjourn the August 1, 2016 Meeting of the City Council, seconded by Norman Schippert, with all Council Members present voting in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 pm.
