MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL  
Monday, August 6,  
2018

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, August 6, 2018. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Henry Walser, Paige Bjorn, Norman Schippert, and Rex Florence. Also, in attendance were City Attorney, John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A motion was made by Henry Walser to approve the July 2, 2018 Minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Paige Bjorn seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

**New Business:** Motion was made by Norman Schippert and seconded by Henry Walser for Introduction and First Reading of the Ordinance Adopting a Supplement to the Code of Ordinances for the City of Pewee Valley (2018 revision) and the vote in favor was unanimous. Attorney Singler read the ordinance in summary. Motion to approve the Pewee Valley Women's Club temporary sign permit presented by Norman Schippert, seconded by Paige Bjorn and approved by the council. John Singler presented the salary survey requested by the council regarding the pay Ordinance for the Mayor and Council. A motion was made by Henry Walser and seconded by Norman Schippert, to fill in Section 1 of the pay ordinance with a rate of pay for the Mayor of 12,000 a year and the vote in favor was unanimous. A motion was made by Henry Walser and seconded by Paige Bjorn to fill in section 2 of the ordinance with a rate of pay for council members of \$50 a month and the vote in favor was unanimous. A motion was made by Henry Walser and seconded by Paige Bjorn for Introduction and First Reading of an amended ordinance adopting a salary (\$12,000 per year) for the Mayor and council members (\$600 per year) and the vote in favor was unanimous. Attorney Singler read the ordinance in summary.
