MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL

Monday, November 5,
2018

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, November 5, 2018. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Henry Walser, Paige Bjorn, Norman Schippert, Rex Florence, Bethany Major and Michele Pisano. Also, in attendance were City Attorney, John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Motion to approve the temporary sign permit for the Crestwood Civic Club Holiday Home Tour was made by Norman Schippert, seconded by Henry Walser and approved by the Council.

Richard Paulman presented the audit report for the 2017/2018 fiscal year and thanked Stan Clarke for his work. Henry Walser made a motion to approve the audit, seconded by Rex Florence and approved by the council.

Open Comments: Michael Logsdon suggested looking into “Safe Walk to Schools” for road funding and asked if the grates and ditches on Old Forest could be cleaned out for the storm water.
