MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, March 4, 2019. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Henry Walser, Paige Bjorn, Norman Schippert, Michele Pisano, Bethany Major and Rex Florence. Also, in attendance were City Attorney, John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

A motion was made by Henry Walser to approve February 4th, 2019 Minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Paige Bjorn seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

Mayor Rogers will meet with County engineer to see about piggybacking onto the county paving projects to save costs. The Mayor thanked Glenn Rowland for keeping roads and drains clear during inclement weather.
