An announcement was made that Greenhaven and Save a Tree have merged.

Additional announcements were as follows:

PWV has, as in the last 24 years, been granted the title of Tree City USA.

Tree Give Away – general discussion of logistics – size of trees, types, and where to purchase. (Native trees in 5-gallon containers sound promising).

Need to coordinate Environmental Day (April 24) and Tree Give Away Day (April 25).

An unknown number of trees may be distressed secondarily due to seasonal drought.

Special kudos to Glenn Rowland for his exemplary help with PWV trees this year; also, his attending to the fire pit at the Yule Log Festival was most diligent.

Jennifer again addressed the litter problem on Hwy. 146; currently, Glenn is monitoring. His contact info has been given to Jennifer and she will discuss working with him.

Other general topics discussed were Clock plans for CityScape, paver's bids, and misc. items.
