MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL

Monday December 2, 2019

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, December 2, 2019. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Henry Walser, Bethany Major, Rex Florence and Paige Bjorn. Also, in attendance were City Attorney John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

A Motion was made by Henry Walser to approve the November 4, 2019 minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Rex florence seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

Financial Report- Updated financial reports were presented.

Open Comments – Leslee Lamp, of the Women’s Club, recognized that Pewee Valley resident Will Frentz is part of the Deaf Men's National SoccerTeam which made history in Temuco, Chile by winning their first ever international tournament and an automatic qualifying bid to the 2020 Deaf World Cup in South Korea and 2021 Deaflympics. Houston Lane resident, Brian Glenn, brought a proposal for a different distribution for the overages on the Rest Cottage Lane project. The Mayor advised Mr. Glenn to speak with attorney John Singler, who is heading the contacting of residents and collecting of overages.

Police Report- Remove packages off porches asap and if you cannot have a neighbor pick them up for you, with the Holidays there is an increase in theft. If you use private video surveillance at your home or business that records video, the Oldham County Police Department would like to hear from you. The Oldham County Police Department is asking all citizens and businesses in the city to register their privately-owned surveillance camera systems. This is very helpful, as officers respond to criminal incidents, they may be able to see something useful on your security camera footage which may help apprehend/convict a criminal. You would only be contacted if there is a criminal incident in the vicinity of your camera as indicated by your registration.
