The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Wednesday, February 5, 2025. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members: Paige Bjorn, Emily Rademaker, Norman Schippert, Amanda Mudd, and Rhonda Laguna, city attorney John Singler. and clerk Denise Haney Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 6:30PM and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Paige Bjorn made a motion to approve the January 2025, minutes of the City Council Meeting. Seconded by Emily Rademaker and all Council Members present voted in favor.

**Communication/Website-**(Amanda Mudd)- The website will be overhauled and updated. Amanda stated she will be working with our current IT web developer. We will also be streaming the council meetings live once the consulting is finished and equipment is purchased. Amanda asked residents to sign up for Reach Alert (a notification system for emergency alerts) and follow the city on the FB

**Sidewalks/Festivities-** (Emily Rademaker)- The city is looking into adding spring and summer events. Weather permits sidewalk repair and pathway installation, when the weather warms these projects will get underway on Central Avenue.

**Town Hall-** (Norman Schippert)- The faulty door to the museum will be replaced and then renovations will continue on the museum.


**Waste Management/Central Park-** (Rhonda Laguna) – Republic will be setting up an app to help residents track your truck, get alerts on delays, and information about your account. Information will be made available to sign up once it is established. If you have any questions, Rhonda can be reached at 386-4441.

appointing two new members(Amanda Mudd and Paige Bjorn) to the Overlay Committee. A motion to approve the order was made by Paige Bjorn, seconded by Rhonda Laguna, and approved by all council members present.

Municipal Order No. 2, Series 2025 A Municipal Order Relating to The Approval of A Consulting Contract was presented by attorney Singler. This order hires Jim Urban to consult for the overlay commission on historic area designations. A motion was made by Paige Bjorn to accept the order, seconded by Amanda Mudd and all council members present voted in favor.

Attorney Singler introduced by summary Ordinance 1, Series 2025 an ordinance relating to a Moratorium on Issuance of Permits within areas proposed for protection as Historic Districts. A motion to accept the introduction and first reading was made by Rhonda Laguna, seconded by Amanda Mudd and all council present approved.

This ordinance applies a moratorium on demolition and exterior building permits to be approved for one year or until the historic district is designated. Copies of this ordinance are available at town hall and on the website for review and input prior to the second reading.

#### Open Comments

Michael Logsdon - Michael asked the public to provide feedback to the ordinance prior to the 2nd reading and asked the council members phone numbers be updated on the website so people can voice their concerns to the appropriate people. He also asked if a link could be put on the website for residents to report repairs needed on roads. Amanda said she would add these things to the website.

Clayton Stoess - Clayton asked for clarification on the moratorium. Attorney Singler stated the moratorium is immediate, the ordinance will keep everything static until the process is established.

Jenna Burns thanked the overlay committee for their work and asked if the new ordinance applies to the subdivision of Peace Lane, attorney Singler says it does not apply to the plat approval it applies to demolition and new construction permits..

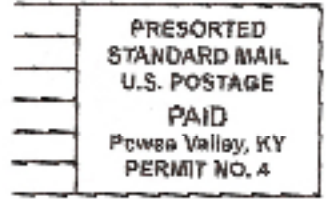
