The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, June 3, 2019. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Norman Schippert, Michele Pisano, Paige Bjorn and Rex Florence. Also, in attendance were City Attorney John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

A Motion was made by Michele Pisano to approve the May 2019 minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Rex Florence seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.

Financial Report- Rex Florence presented the updated financials.
