Monday November 4, 2019

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Monday, October 7, 2019. A Motion was made by Henry Walser to approve the October 7, 2019 minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Bethany Major seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.
