

## Chief of Police, Pewee Valley, Kentucky

The City of Pewee Valley, Kentucky (pop. 1588) seeks an experienced law enforcement professional for the position of Chief of Police. The City is looking for someone interested in a long-term engagement to fill this full-time position. The Chief of Police engages in community-oriented policing, traffic law enforcement, and special projects as needed. This officer manages their own schedule and coordinates with subcontractors and maintains policing relationships with County agencies to deliver 24/7 law enforcement for the City of Pewee Valley.

Pewee Valley is a residential community approximately 20 miles from downtown Louisville with 600+ homes. The Pewee Valley Police is a small-town police department and has traditionally been a one-man department. The Police Chief conducts primary policing of the City. Extra help is hired and managed by the Police Chief as needed. We encourage retired officers to consider this position and apply. The Pewee Valley Police Dept. is not part of the Kentucky Retirement System. Salary range is \$65,000 to 70,000.

### Objectives:

- Operate with honor, integrity, and courage in a professional manner, that is courteous, and equitable.
- Protect life and property, preserve the peace, prevent crime, apprehend criminals, and enforce laws and ordinances.
- Build strong relationships between the City and the general public, as well as other city employees, contractors to the city, and County Law Enforcement.
- Maintain absolute confidentiality of work-related issues and city information.
- Participate in job-related training and courses to maintain skills, knowledge, and ability.

### Responsibilities:

- Provide patrol services to all business, residential, and academic areas.
- Respond to emergency calls and citizen complaints.
- Work with County Officials in criminal investigations
- Make arrests when necessary
- Render credible information as a witness in court and for other police duties.
- Manage law enforcement sub-contractors and part-time employees.
- Provide first aid to the physically injured.

### Required qualifications:

- 10+ years of active law enforcement experience
- Advanced law enforcement training
- Verifiable record of effective leadership and cooperation with community members and city administration
- High School diploma or equivalent
- Valid driver's license and good driving record
- Current certification as a law enforcement officer
- Be in good physical condition
- Ability to pass an extensive background investigation

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

Additional skills should include:

- Experience with leadership in other law enforcement organizations
- Problem solving and crime prevention expertise
- Efficient at working with a budget
- Inspires confidence
- Communicates effectively with the public
- Self-motivated capable of self-management
