MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL

Weds September 4, 2019

The regular meeting of the City Council of Pewee Valley, Kentucky was held on Wednesday, September 4, 2019. In attendance were Mayor Bob Rogers, Council Members Henry Walser, Norman Schippert, Rex Florence, and Paige Bjorn. Also, in attendance were City Attorney John Singler and clerk Denise Haney.

Mayor Rogers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

A Motion was made by Henry Walser to approve the August 5, 2019 minutes of the City Council Meeting as written. Paige Bjorn seconded the motion and all Council Members present voted in favor.
